Chemistry

Saliba is a Professor in Chemistry at the American University of Beirut.

Saliba leads several projects related to understanding the chemistry of inhalable tobacco and non-tobacco smoke and atmospheric aerosols. In addition, many of her most recent projects concentrate on community- led environmental projects that are based on the co-production of knowledge for finding the most suited local solutions.

She is the co-founder and executive director of Khaddit Beirut and the Director and founder of the Environment Academy (EA). In 2021, she was nominated by Apolitical's the 12 most influential people in climate justice. In 2019, she received the 2019 L'Oreal-UNESCO International Award for Women in Science and the Paul Harris Fellow Pin from the Rotary Club Beirut Cedars. Also, in 2019 she was voted among the top 100 most influential women by BBC.
