She is founder and co-founder of two start-ups, in Sweden and Finland, respectively. She has also been a jury member for the Albanian ICT Awards, one of the main technology events in Albania. She is a Marie Curie Ph.C. Fellow and will be defending her Ph.D. in October 2021 in Bilbao, Spain. As part of the Marie Curie Alumni Association, where she holds the position as a board member for the Western Balkans Chapter and the National Representative for Albania, she has organized various science events, particularly research ethics, in the region.
