Staša Babić is a Serbian archaeologist and a professor of archaeology in the Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Belgrade. Since 2009 she has been Head of the Department of Archaeology.

Broadly speaking, her research deals with



the language and vocabulary of archaeology, archaeological theory and the Iron Age in the Balkans. Regarding the latter, some of her specific topics of study include: contact between Greeks and barbarians in the Central Balkans during the Iron Age, prehistoric settlements in the Klisura-Kadića Brdo area, written sources in Iron Age research in the Balkans, contact between Late Dynastic Egypt and Archaic Greece, southern Serbia in the second half of the first millennium B.C., and the attitude of the Balkan people towards Ancient Rome.

Babić is described as one of the key thinkers in the Balkans on archaeological theory.
