(54) **DEVICE TO HOLD ELASTIC BAGS TO THE DOG BODY FOR THE COLLECTION OF EXCREMENTS**

(57) Bag for receiving the excrements and harness for fixing the collection assembly to the dog's body, the harness being provided with adjustable buckles for receiving the ends of the belt (1) which are associated through a laminar belt closed upon itself by means of a central buckle (5) wherein is fastened the upper belt of the supporting harness (12) which presents a bifurcation

from the upper belt and determines two side prolongations (7) defining a central opening provided for the tail of the animal (6) and an outlet for the excrements; two adjustable lower belts (8) extend from the supporting harness, and anchoring means (9) are provided to attach the bag (4) to the supporting harness.

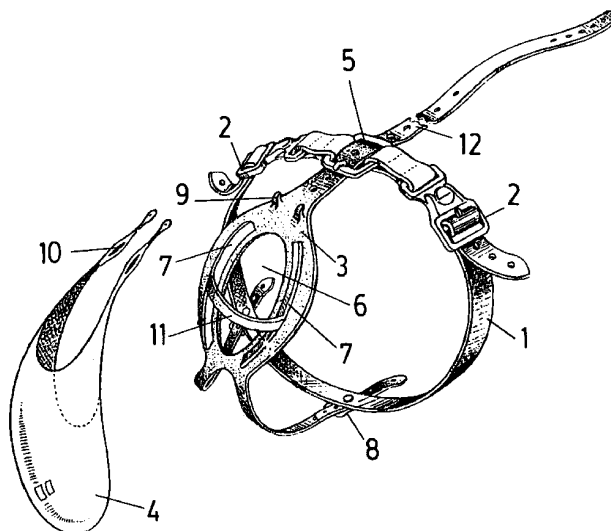
